Support to Flood and Landslide Affected Community Schools at Lalitpur District, Nepal

1. Executive Summary

This report provides an update on the progress of the project initiated by the Rotary Club of Kasthamandap to support schools affected by severe floods and landslides in Lalitpur district following unprecedented rainfall in late September 2024. Despite initial delays due to legal compliances, the project is now well underway, with significant work completed across all three selected schools. The project aims to restore essential services and ensure a safe learning environment for approximately 740 students.

2. Background of the Disaster

In late September 2024, Nepal experienced exceptionally heavy rainfall, resulting in widespread flooding and landslides, particularly affecting the Kathmandu Valley. The Bagmati and Nakkhu rivers overflowed, causing extensive damage in the Lalitpur district. This disaster, which recorded over 10 inches of rainfall in the Kathmandu Valley in two days—the heaviest in over five decades—led to over 200 fatalities nationwide.

3. Project Overview and Affected Schools

Three schools in Lalitpur were identified for support based on the extent of damage:

- **Shreedevi Basic School in Nallu:** (200 students) Suffered damage to reserve tanks, water pipelines, and Early Child Development (ECD) class resources.

- **Shree Bageshwori Basic School in Tahakhel:** (250 students) Faced challenges with reserve tanks, toilets, and ECD classes.
- **Shree Gamvir Samudra Setu Secondary School:** (290 students) Encountered damages requiring management of classroom amenities, such as desks and benches.

The project's comprehensive plan aims to restore essential services and ensure a safe learning environment, benefiting around 740 students from these three schools.

Funding Contributions:

The project was generously funded by:

- **Rotary International District 2820 Foundation Committee, Japan:** USD 7,988.00 (NRs. 1,093,557.20)
- **Rotary Club of Kasthamandap, Nepal:** NRs. 215,000.00

4. Project Implementation Timeline and Challenges

The project initially hit a snag with delays in fund release, stemming from legal compliance requirements with Nepal's Social Welfare Council. However, **Service Project Chair, Past President Rtn. Prabhu Ram Bhandary**, successfully accelerated the implementation.

While the final project completion was originally slated for the end of June, the delayed fund release pushed the schedule to July. Nevertheless, the project was successfully completed within the **Rotary Year 2025-26**.

5. Final project Completion

On **July 18, 2025**, a delegation from the **Rotary Club of Kasthamandap**, including the Charter President, Past Presidents, current President, Club Members, Anns, and Rotaractors, made a final visit to all three designated schools. The purpose of this visit was to conduct a final observation, confirm project completion, and officially hand over the project, which was generously supported by **Rotary International District 2820**.

Despite a flooded bridge caused by heavy rain, the team successfully reached **Shreedevi Basic School at Nallu**. The handover ceremony was witnessed by the School Management Committee Chairman and local representatives. Principal Mr. Surendra Ghalan expressed his profound gratitude, acknowledging and thanking the **Japanese Rotarians** for their vital support in toilet reconstruction, drinking water management, water and sanitation improvements, and the provision of early childhood development materials. He also specifically extended his appreciation for the school being painted.

During our visit to **Shree Bageshwori Basic School in Tahakhel, Lalitpur**, Principal Eknath Bajgain, along with the School Management Committee's chairman and the Chief of Godavari Municipality Education Department, extended their heartfelt thanks and gratitude. They specifically recognized the **Rotary Club of Kasthamandap** and **RI District 2820, Japan**, for their crucial support in the construction of toilets, improvements in water and sanitation facilities, the provision of furniture, and their contribution to the Early Child Development program through the provision of essential ECD materials.

At **Shree Gamvir Samudra Setu Secondary School**, Principal Ms. Neera Shrestha conveyed her gratitude for the project. The Chairman and members of the School Management Committee, along with the teachers, were present to welcome our team for the final handover of desks, benches, and Early Childhood Development (ECD) materials for two classrooms.
